The expulsion shall be suspended and the student will be enrolled in Willows High School with conditions. If the conditions are violated, he will be placed at Willows Community High School. The student should seek and show successful attendance in a counseling program outside the District (at no cost to the District). A counselor/site administrator will review this contract with the student upon his/her return to school after signing this document. Student will not leave campus after arriving without first obtaining permission form administration. Any violation of the Stipulated Expulsion Order, which includes 20 hours of volunteer community service, will result in the Student's immediate expulsion and placement in the Willows Community High School without further Board Hearing.
- 3. (Action) Consider expulsion of Student #2008-09-04. Administration recommends: Student #2008-09-04 be expelled through the end of the spring semester of 2008/09. The Student will be placed in the Willows High Community Day School. Student should seek and show successful attendance in a substance abuse counseling program outside the District (at no cost to the District). Periodic drug testing will be completed at no cost to the District. A counselor/site administrator will review this contract with the student upon his/her return to school after signing this document. Student will complete 20 hours of volunteer community service.
