Dear Parents of 8th Grade Students:

The second semester is an especially important time for 8th Grade students. They are anxiously finishing their middle school years, and are working hard to meet all of their requirements to move on to high school. There are numerous end of year activities for students graduating from Willows Intermediate School. It is my hope that all students graduate and participate in all of the activities. Please make note of the discipline policy for 8th Graders that goes into effect at the beginning of the second semester. Below is a copy of the policy as it reads in our student handbook:

EIGHTH GRADE DISCIPLINE POLICY

Eighth graders who cut school during the second semester will receive a major referral each time they cut. A major referral will be issued for cutting class and it will count against 8th grade privileges such as the year-end trip, the graduation ceremony, and the graduation dance. Other penalties may also result as mentioned elsewhere in this handbook.

Eighth graders who receive two or more major referrals during the second semester of their 8th grade year can expect the following penalties:

2 or more majors: Barred from participation in the 8th grade year-end trip.

3 or more majors: Barred from participation in the 8th grade dance.

4 or more majors: Barred from participation in the 8th grade graduation ceremony.

I hope that this information will help you to monitor your child's behavior. The Staff and Administration at WIS is striving to work in tandem with parents, to continue to make our school an effective and positive environment for all students.
