AGENDA TOPIC: School Plan for Student Achievement Addendum 18-19

Background Information:

Due to FPM review, Murdock Elementary School needed to make changes to their 18-19 School Plan for Student Achievement (SPSA) as the 19-20 SPSA is still in progress. Changes made included a new goal for English Learners which demonstrated how Title III funds were being utilized.

California *Education Code* 64001 and the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) requires schools that receive federal funds through the ConApp to consolidate all school planning requirements into the SPSA. In order to realign the SPSA to ESSA and the LCAP, the CDE is providing an updated SPSA template this year and next year. The new SPSA template is to assist LEAs and schools in meeting the content requirements for consolidating all school plans.

Recommendations:

Approve the annual update of the School Plan for Student Achievement for Murdock Elementary School.

Planned Improvements in Student Performance

School Goal #4

The School Site Council has analyzed the academic performance of all student groups and has considered the effectiveness of key elements of the instructional program for students failing to meet student performance targets. As a result, it has adopted the following school goals, related actions, and expenditures to raise the academic performance of students not yet meeting state standards:

Willows Unified School District will provide high quality classroom instruction and curriculum that promotes college and career readiness with academic interventions in place to better ensure student success.

Increase one ELPAC Proficiency level overall and/or in one of the four domains (listening, speaking, reading, writing) per year per EL student.

ELPAC results, CA School Dashboard

Findings from the Analysis of this Data:

From the 17-18 ELPAC results, Murdock had 25 students out of 202 that were reclassified based on the state ELPAC criteria set for the 18-19 school year. According to the Dashboard, 14.9% of Murdock EL students are well developed, 39.1% are moderately developed, 26.2% are somewhat developed, and 19.8% are in the beginning stage.

How the School will Evaluate the Progress of this Goal:

Murdock will continue to monitor ELD student progress through classroom observations during ELD instruction, progress on student report cards, formal and informal assessments, and data discussion at DELAC and ELAC.
